## MINI Cooper 2015-23 RedlineGoods automatic shift boot install guide

1. Carefully pry off the face pieces from the shift handle.



2. Disconnect the ribbon cable from the circuit board.



3. Lift up the outer trim piece.



4. Like a manual shifter, you could pull the shifter off, but if you do, it will likely destroy the ribbon cable. Instead, use a screwdriver or other tool to pry the shift handle up slowly, just to get it disconnected from the shifter.



- a. For this step, it may be easier to cut off the boot with a knife and cut the small trim ring with side-cutters. This will allow you to pull the ribbon cable thru without damaging it.
- b. Carefully slide the shift handle up until you can get the ribbon cable thru the boot.

5. If the ribbon cable is damaged, the entire shifter assembly is the replacement part. You cannot order only the cable.



6. Remove any remaining boot material from the large trim ring. Note which side is toward the front of the car. The ring can only go in 1 way.



7. Glue the new boot to the large trim ring. The longer side is toward the front of the car.



8. Install the boot ring into the large trim ring, then thread the ribbon cable thru the boot.



9. Install the shift handle, connect the ribbon cable, and attach the lower face plate.



10. Lift the outer trim and place a zip-tie around the boot and the shift handle. The handle can then be slide down until it clicks into place.



11. Snap the trim ring back into place and snap the front face plate back together.



Congratulations – and enjoy your new shift boot from RedlineGoods!

## Useful tip

Make sure to condition your new shift boot properly, using the proper care products for the material you've chosen for your shift boot (leather and Alcantara require different treatments) and you'll enjoy it for years!
